

Tour Information and Conditions

Carefully read this brochure and the tour conditions as enrollment in payment for any program offered herein constitutes acceptance and agreement to be bound by the terms thereof.

PURPOSE OF TOUR: It must be understood by all who tour with Calvary Chapel that our purpose is to study Israel from a biblical perspective. Therefore, the bible will be our guide and will be studied at each location. However, ample time will be given for shopping, leisure, free time, sight seeing and rest. Initial_____

TRIPLE ROOMS/CHILDREN: Triple accommodations can be arranged, but few genuine triple-bedded rooms exist. To make a triple, a cot, rollaway or sofa bed is added to a regular twin-bedded room. Such accommodations are not suitable for three adults nor are any reduction in cost offered by the hotels. For children twelve years of age and older, full land cost applies. Unaccompanied minors under 18 years of age can participate in this tour with notarized permission slip signed by parent or guardian. Initial_____

LUGGAGE: One piece of luggage per person is included. On airlines, free baggage allowance for Economy Class passengers is according to the size and not weight. Passengers will be allowed one piece of luggage. The total measurement of this piece may not exceed 62 inches. Total measurement is length plus height plus width. Apart from the usual accessories (hand bag, carry-cot, camera, umbrella, etc.) each passenger may carry one piece of luggage that must remain in the personal care of the tour member throughout the tour. Airline liability for passenger's baggage is stated on contract, included on all tickets and shall not exceed the actual loss, subject to proof. Baggage is at "Owner's Risk" throughout the tour. HOTELS: All hotels are with private bath or shower. Per person cost based on sharing twin-bedded rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement indicated. Initial_____

AIR/HOTEL/AND TOUR MEAL SERVICE: On tour, meals consist of breakfast and dinner daily. Coffee and/or tea included with breakfast, but as is customary overseas not included with dinner and is an extra cost if requested. Meals while in-flight are according to custom of airline involved and shall be considered the meal service appropriate to the time of day.

Airline flight schedules may cause a missed meal service enroute for which no responsibility can be accepted. Special dietary meals cannot be guaranteed on the land tour. Initial_____

NON SMOKING AND ALCOHOL POLICY: Smoking is not permitted on transfer and touring motor coaches. In effort to not stumble a fellow believer and to maintain a positive witness, alcoholic beverages will not be allowed anytime during the tour. Even though one might have the liberty to consume alcohol, while a member of this tour you are accepting the responsibility to not partake of alcohol anytime during the tour. If any further clarification is needed, please talk with your Pastor. Initial_____

GRATUITIES/VISA FEES/MISCELLANEOUS TAXES: Local, State, Airport boarder crossing and hotel taxes are included in tour price. Furthermore, tips to waiters, guides and drivers are also included in the tour price; therefore, it will not be necessary to tip anyone who provides a service to the entire group. Initial_____

EXTRA COSTS: If you are traveling alone and wish to share accommodations, we will assign you a roommate, if one is available. If there is not one with whom you can share, you will be invoiced for a single room. Please contact us regarding supplement for a single room. Items not mentioned as being included, but not limited to passport fees, beverages and meals other than those mentioned, laundry or dry-cleaning and all other items of a personal nature are at the full expense of tour members. DEPOSITS/CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: Tour price is \$3,000.00. A non-refundable non-transferable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to confirm tour acceptance. A monthly payment plan has been established to aid in saving for the tour. If you choose not to be enrolled with the monthly saving plan, then further non-refundable deposits of \$300.00 are due by August 29, 2010, October 24, 2010, January 23, 2011 and March 20, 2011. The remaining balance is to be paid in full no later than August 14, 2011. Any cancellations after January 2011, a \$150.00 per person cancellation fee will be applied in addition to the forfeiture of the non refundable deposits previously made. The tour package is non-refundable if canceled less than 30 (thirty) days prior to departure. Please make all checks payable to CC Fargo, and in the memo section write CCIT2011. See attached payment guide for more details. Initial_____

TOUR SAVINGS PLAN: Figure out what minimum payment is due each month to be paid in full by August 7th, 2011. The same amount of money will be non-refundable as already stated in the previous section. Finally, you must be current with monthly installments to remain secure in your place on the tour. Initial_____

DOCUMENTS/HEALTH/HANDICAPPED: A valid passport must be held by each tour member, with at least six months remaining past the last day of the tour. Application forms are available at your local Passport Office or at select U.S. Post Offices. No vaccination or re-vaccination is required nor is any particular health requirement applicable. Tour members are expected to be in good health. Tour members who require any form of special assistance must be accompanied by a helper who is totally responsible for those tour members. RESPONSIBILITY/MANAGEMENT: The tour company and/or its agents act only in the capacity of an agent for the participant in all matters connected with hotel accommodations, sight seeing, transportation, whether by rail, air, motor coach, boat or other types of conveyance and other components constituting the tour, and as agent hold itself, its agents or subagents, free of responsibility for any injury, loss, damage, accident, delay, irregularity, or additional expense arising from changes in schedule, fire, weather, breakdown in machinery or equipment, sickness, quarantines, acts of governments or other authorities, wars, hostilities, civil disturbances, strikes, riots, theft, pilferage, improper documentation, or for any cause beyond its control. The tour agent shall not be liable for any act of omission by an individual or firm contracted for services or facilities on behalf of the participant. We also reserve the right to withdraw tour, reschedule the departure, amend the itinerary, substitute hotels of comparable quality, and generally make any alteration or unforeseen conditions beyond our control deem changes necessary.
